

If you or a family member have tested your autosomal DNA at 23andMe®, AncestryDNA™, or MyHeritage™, you can transfer your results to FamilyTreeDNA for free by uploading your raw data file. After transferring your file, your autosomal data is added to our database, and you will receive a list of your autosomal matches and have access to our Family Finder – Matrix tool. The Matrix feature allows you to select and compare the autosomal DNA relationship between up to ten of your matches at one time.

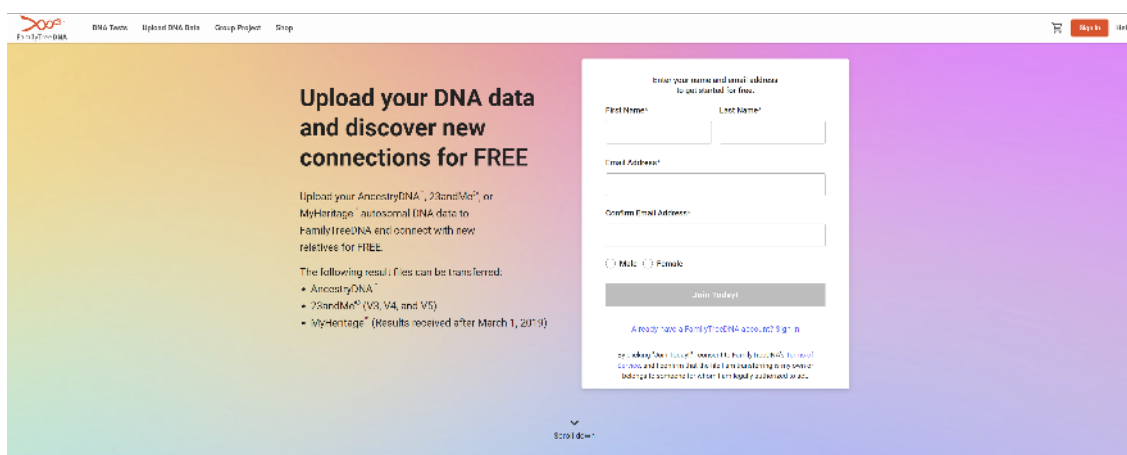
Important: Each account is for one individual. If you have an existing FamilyTreeDNA kit and are attempting to upload data for a different individual, you MUST create a new account for the transfer.

After transferring, you can unlock all other Family Finder features, which include the Chromosome Browser, Chromosome Painter, myOrigins, and ancientOrigins, for only \$19. Simply click one of those features on the dashboard at any time after upload and you will be prompted to make payment for the unlock.

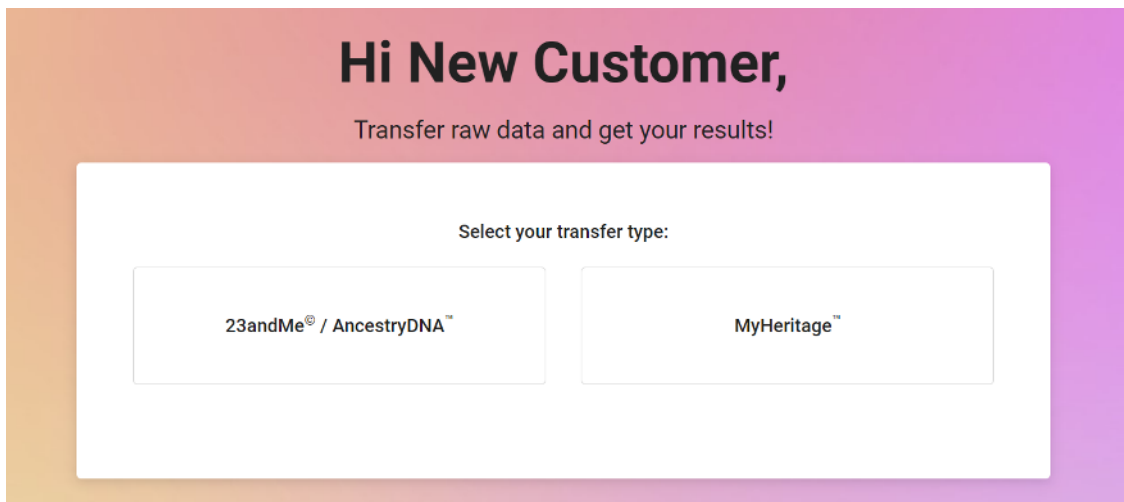
Please note that we only accept 23andMe®, AncestryDNA, and MyHeritage™. Transfers from Living DNA and Helix are not compatible with our platform and so we are not able to accept them.

How to Upload your Autosomal Transfer Data

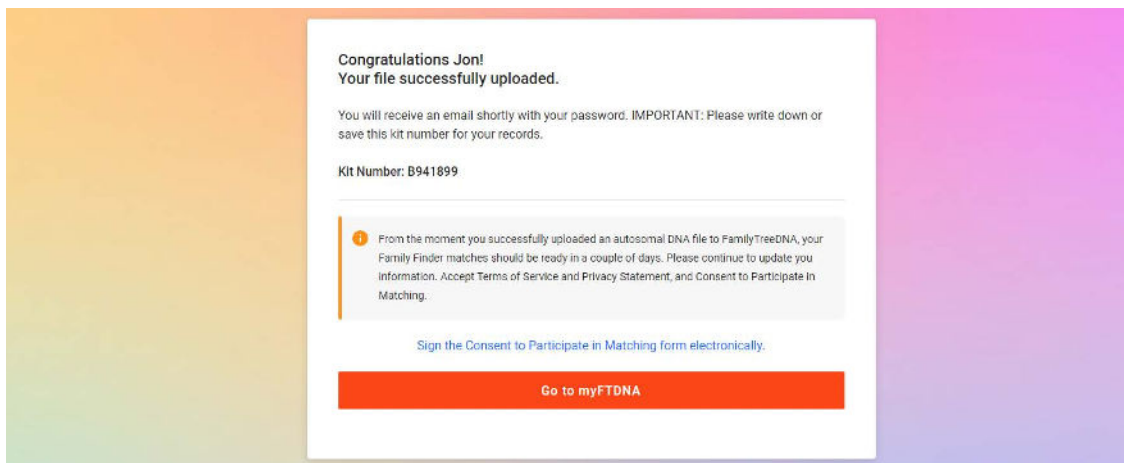
1. To access the upload portal, visit www.familytreedna.com/autosomal-transfer



2. If you already have an account, click on the blue “Already have a FamilyTreeDNA account? Sign in” link. Otherwise, complete the and click "Join Today!" You'll be directed to the upload page. *If you are transferring someone else's data, make sure to enter their name and gender, NOT yours.*
3. By clicking “Join Today,” you are agreeing to FamilyTreeDNA’s Terms of Service and affirming that the file you are transferring belongs to someone for whom you have the legal permission to act in this situation.
4. Select the type of transfer file you wish to upload. Uploading to the site could take several minutes.



5. Once you select a file, the file name will be displayed in the boxed area.
Choosing the MyHeritage™ option will prompt you to sign into the associated account on the MyHeritage™ website.
6. If everything looks correct, click "Submit" to begin uploading the file.
7. After your file has successfully uploaded, the confirmation page will display the kit number. **The kit number will be your username.** An email containing the account's password will be sent to the email address you entered on the transfer page.



8. Click "Go to myFTDNA" to begin onboarding. The transfer may take up to a week to process, depending on processing volume.

Note: You will need to sign the Release Form to review your matches or access the Matrix comparison tool. You may click the "Sign the release form electronically" link to do so at this time or wait until later. Don't forget, you can unlock the Chromosome Browser, Chromosome Painter, myOrigins, and ancientOrigins features for only \$19.
